**1 ▲ Okeechobee, Fla.** Located on 45 acres within the Pine Creek Sporting Club, this large, ranch-style home has a 12-foot-deep wrap-around porch with a cypress ceiling. The house is being sold fully furnished and has slate floors, a double-sided river-rock fireplace, and a master suite with French doors that open to the porch. 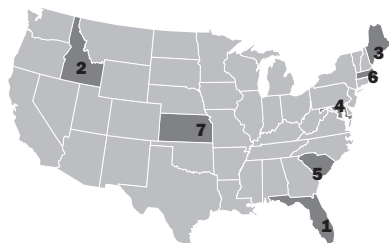
